Momentum Center Driver

DESCRIPTION: Extended Grace/Momentum Center is a non-profit grassroots movement to create a stigma free community where every person is fully visible and connected. The Momentum Center for Social Engagement is a social and recreational program for teenagers and for adults with mental illness, addiction, and developmental disabilities.

PURPOSE OF POSITION: The focus of this position is to safely transport members or other identified individuals using our bus. This position is utilized on an "as needed" basis.

REPORTS TO: This person reports directly to the Chief Operations Officer.

HOURS: This is a float position with a fluctuating schedule based on weekly need. This is not a part time or full-time position. There is a maximum of 20 hours per week.

QUALIFICATIONS: The successful candidate will demonstrate the ability to safely transport members and other passengers in the Momentum Center van.

Some requirements include:

- High school diploma or GED
- Valid driver's license with acceptable driving record
- Bilingual in English and Spanish preferred
- Previous experience as public transportation driver preferred, but not required
- Thorough knowledge of traffic laws, ordinances, and practices involved with safe vehicle operation.
- Experience in a non-profit setting, as an employee, intern, or volunteer
- Experience and comfort interacting with people who have mental illness, addiction, and/or disabilities or barriers of language and culture, while exercising appropriate boundaries
- Efficient time-management skills
- Alignment with the Momentum Center values, core characteristics and Diversity/Equity/Inclusion Statement
- Ability to show empathy and compassion while maintaining clear personal boundaries

JOB DUTIES:

- 1. Provide safe transportation to/from Grand Haven, Holland, and other parts Ottawa County.
- 2. Provides friendly and courteous communication while interacting with passengers.
- 3. Ensures passengers follow safety protocols when riding the Momentum Center vehicle.
- 4. Transport passengers and arrive to destination in a timely manner.

- 5. Makes weekly inspections of bus for items such as burned-out bulbs, low tire pressure, etc.
- 6. Assists individuals with physical needs in boarding and departing the bus via the lift ramp.
- 7. Refuels the bus when needed.
- 8. Ensures bus is clean before an after transporting guests.
